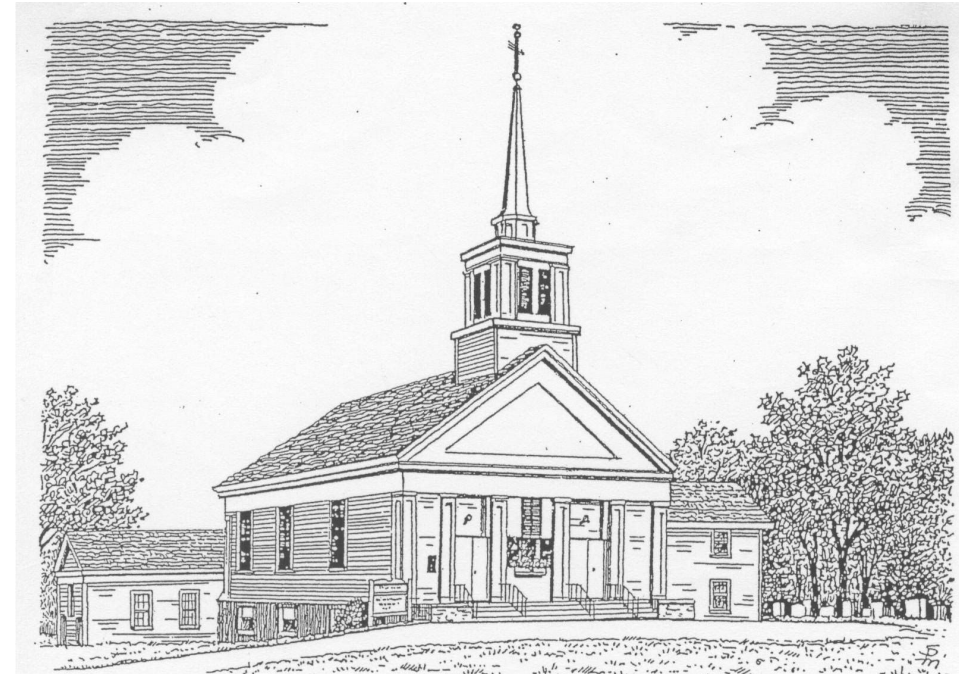
Announcements
